




These messages could not be more important at this current time, where we all have to work together to keep each other safe and well.

Hands, Face, Space.

You will be aware of the new Government campaign for tackling Covid-19 over the winter. Your child stays in a bubble during school and washes their hands frequently. We ask that you support this campaign for the safety of our community.

Space (social distancing)

At the end of the school day, parents are currently allowed into the playground to collect their children.

However, there have been occasions where social distancing is not occurring. We have seen parents from different households talking closely, sitting together and even hugging!

We urge you to keep a 2 metre distance from each other, there is plenty of room to do this. Please do not congregate and talk near the gates.

We ask that only one person collects your child, and you leave the playground as soon as possible. Please supervise your children—they should not be playing.

We are doing so well as a community - let's keep it up!




Well done Nursery!
