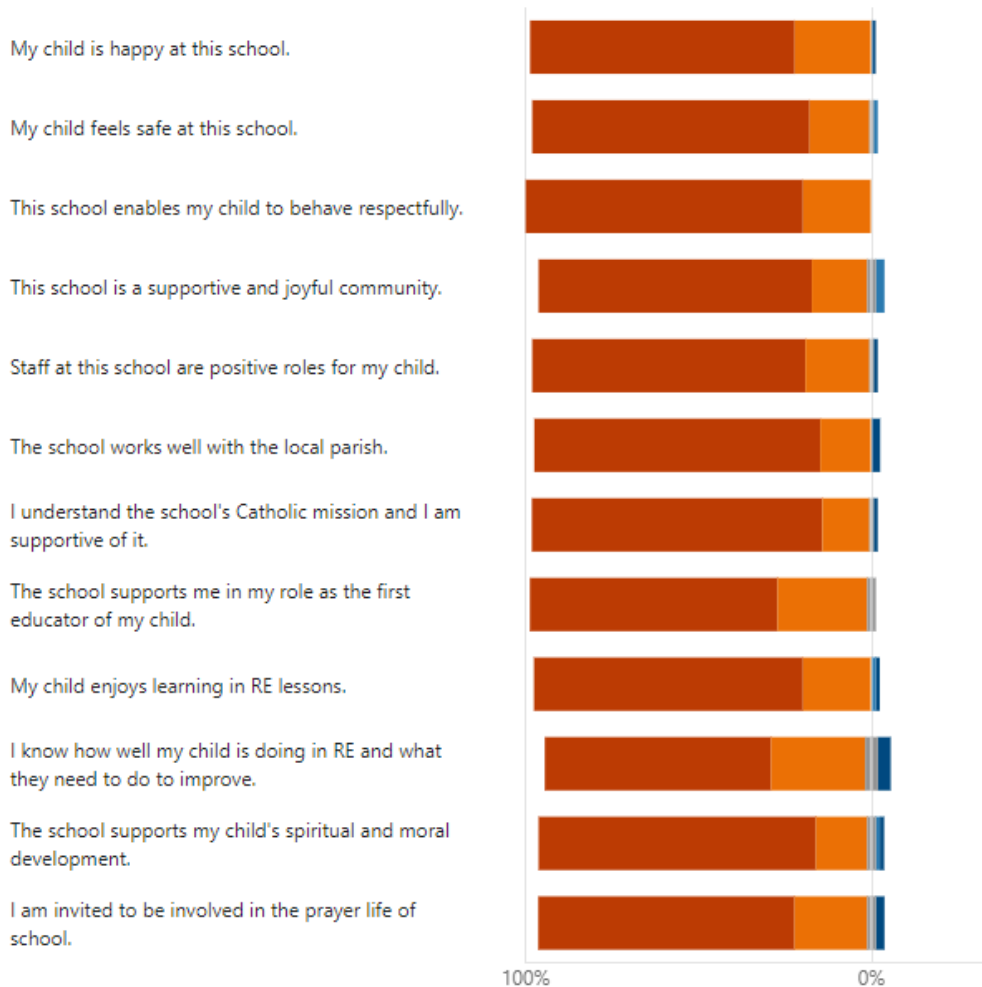
Parents Questionnaire October 2023

- Continue to look for ways to serve the Parish.
- Ensure parents know to look on the school website to see what their child is learning in R.E, and ask questions about how their child is achieving in RE during parents' evenings. R.E is also reported on separately in the end of year report.
- Invite parents in to pray with their children- Stay and Pray sessions during the season of Advent.
- Ensure all children get the opportunity to take the Class Prayer Bag home to encourage families to be part of the prayer life at school.
