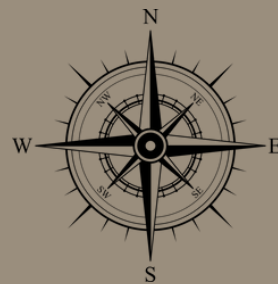


YEAR 6 SUMMER TERM

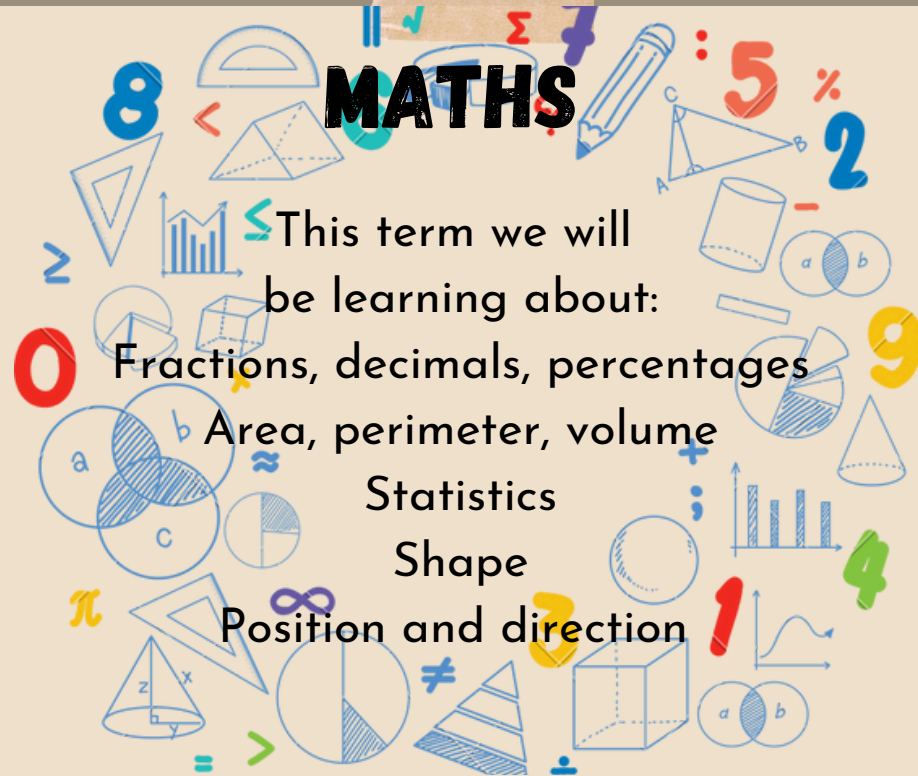
