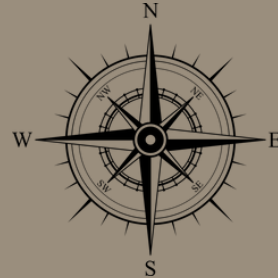


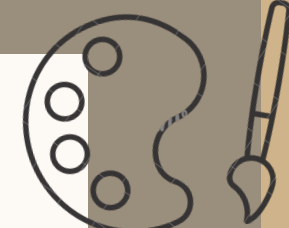
YEAR 6 SUMMER TERM

- Continents and Oceans

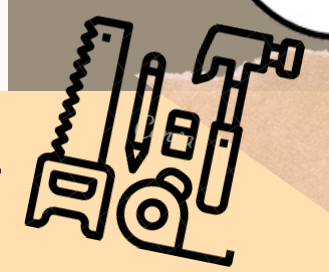


ART

Using our class texts, we will be writing narratives, character and setting descriptions using figurative language, dialogue, letters, reports, and monologues.

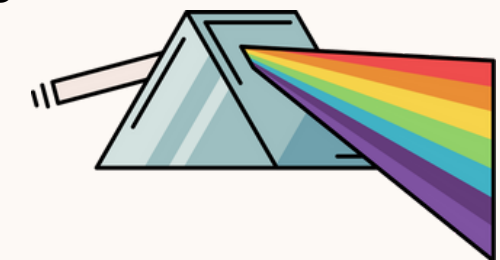
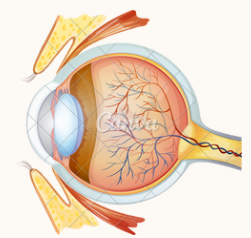
