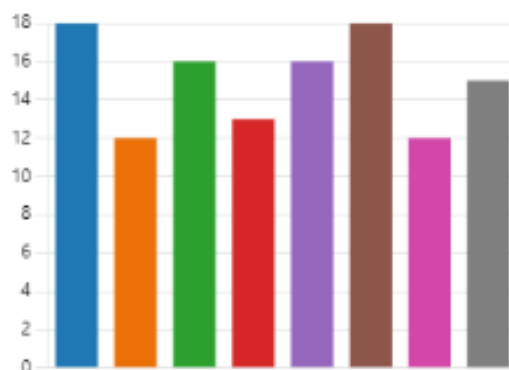
Parent Questionnaire Summary Autumn 2024

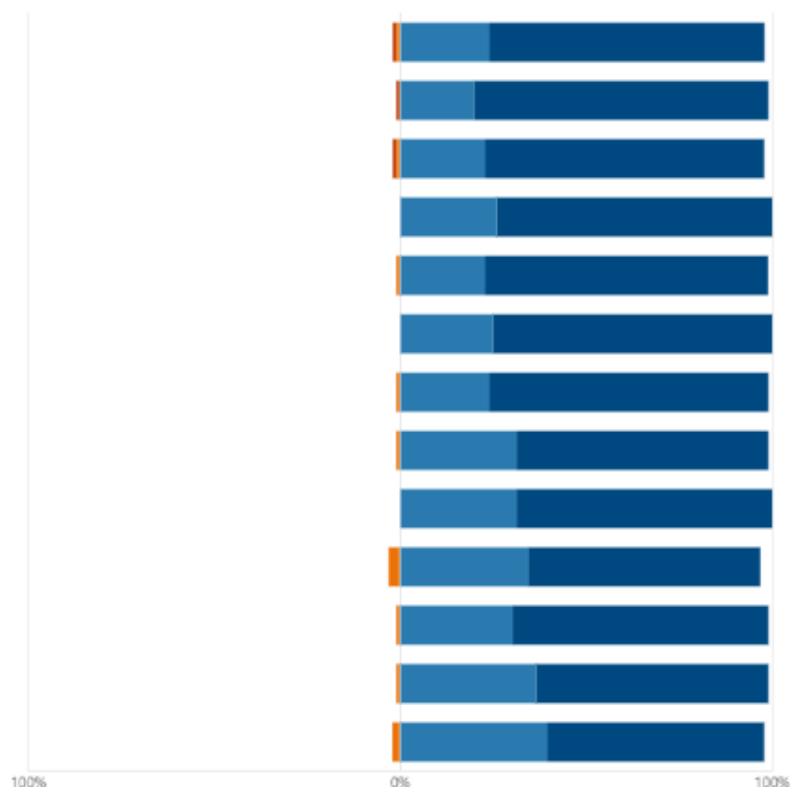
