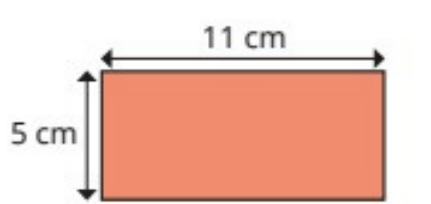
MATHS

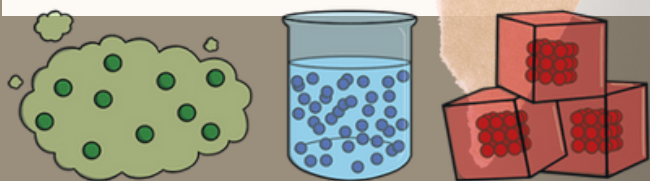


ENGLISH

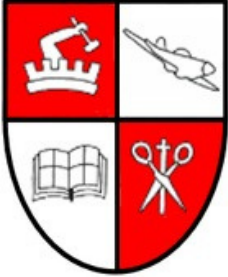
