Using our class texts, we will be writing narratives, character and setting descriptions using figurative language, dialogue, letters, reports, and monologues.

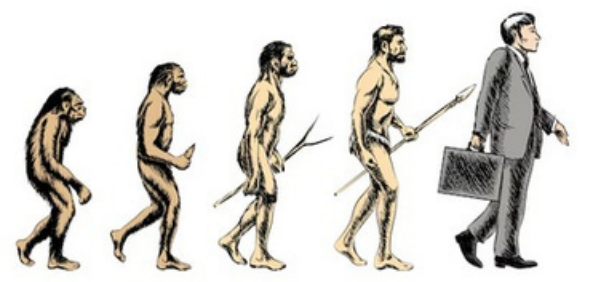
- We will also be focussing on using:

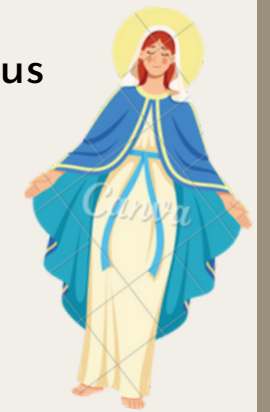

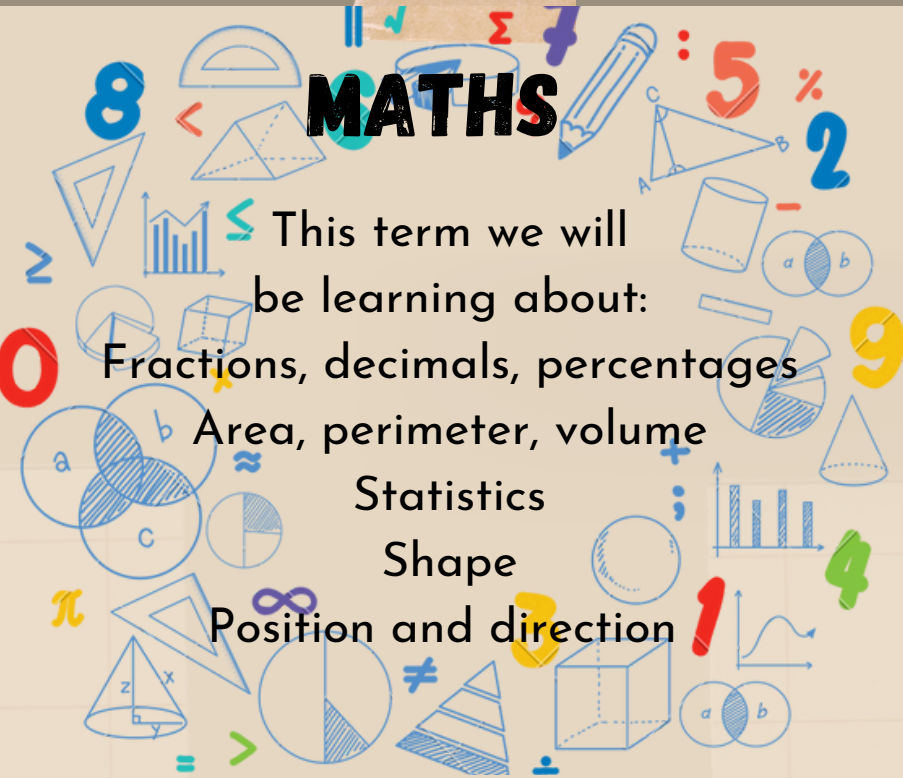
